ABSTRACT

This research investigated both secondary and primary data, which the researcher collected by using survey questionnaires. The 60 samples included high school students, academic staffs and academic support staffs of the Demonstration School of Suan Sunandha Rajabhat University. This quantitative research analyzed and represented data in descriptive statistics to describe information about the personal factors of the manual quality assessment and quality level Military Student Application Guide of the Demonstration School of Suan Sunandha Rajabhat University divided by line of work using frequency distribution, percentage, mean and standard deviation. It is used in conjunction with the mean to characterize the distribution of the data. By studying the design development, efficiency and application for military courses for high school students from a questionnaire and bring to conclusions by using descriptive statistics.

The results indicated that personnel, students and parents had a greater understanding of the application manual for military students as the manual has become more efficient, the contents are arranged in clear order without confusion allowing readers to follow the content easily as well as having a connection to the topic with an average of 4.42. In addition, the study indicated that lack of knowledge in the application process for some of the high school military student course has hindered the development of the military student enrollment guide for high school students. Based on this information, it has led to suggestions for resolving obstacles and developing designs and creating a more effective application for military student enrollment manuals for high school students.

RESEARCH RESULTS

They have organized the content clearly in sequence, not confusing, and conveniently allowing the reader to follow the content and maintain topic continuity at a high level (average = 3.76). They provide appropriate recommendations for work practices, problem-solving strategies, and insert additional thoughts and opinions that are beneficial to the system, at a high level (average = 3.65). Lastly, it is a document indicating the working procedures related to the main responsibilities of the position and has a complete and accurate structure and content in accordance with academic standards, at a high level (average = 3.56). In addition, after receiving the guidelines, they organized the content clearly in sequence, not confusing, and conveniently allowing the reader to follow the content and maintain topic continuity at the highest level (average = 4.42). The academic content is up-to-date, generating new knowledge or techniques, at the highest level (average = 4.37). They have studied textbooks, documents, and/or research reports to help readers acquire knowledge and abilities or stimulate further research, at the highest level (average = 4.22). They use clear, appropriate, and linguistically correct language, at a high level (average = 4.15). By and large, the majority of the sample group has a deeper understanding of the guidelines for enrolling military students. The average is 0.20, 0.42, 0.57, 0.39, and 0.7 in order.

The analysis of the understanding of the guidelines for enrolling military students at Suan Sunandha Rajabhat University Demonstration School shows the following results:

1. The document demonstrating the working procedures related to the main responsibilities of the position and having a complete and accurate structure and content has increased by 0.73.
2. The organization of the content in a clear sequence, non-confusing, convenient for readers to follow, and maintaining topic continuity has increased by 0.65.
3. The suggestions for work practices, problem-solving strategies, and inserting additional thoughts and opinions that are beneficial to the system have increased by 0.58.

4. The punctuation and spacing proficiency has increased by 0.54.

SUMMARY AND DISCUSSION

The analysis found that the quality evaluation of the military student admission handbook of Suan Sunandha Rajabhat University Demonstration School is overall of high level. When considering specific aspects, it was found that the first priority is clearly outlining and explaining the content in a way that is understandable and interesting, which is of the highest level. Additionally, the content is up-to-date and contributes to the readers' knowledge and skills, which is also rated as high. Overall, the evaluation of the handbook is at a high level, especially when considering specific aspects such as the seamless organization of the content. Clear and coherent in sequence, not confusing, and easily followed by the reader, as well as having interlinked topics, are rated as the highest level. Additionally, having up-to-date and innovative academic content is also rated as the highest level. Providing practical work recommendations, problem-solving guidelines, and appropriate additional thoughts and opinions that are beneficial to the system are rated as the highest level. Lastly, specifying work processes and details, referencing rules and regulations, and having a writing reference plan are rated as high. These criteria comply with the standards of handbook development. A good handbook must be clear, easy to understand, beneficial for work and training, suitable for the unit and users, interesting, current, and not outdated.

SUGGESTIONS

In this study, we have identified the effectiveness and importance of the military student enrollment handbook at Suan Sunandha Rajabhat University Demonstration School. The information obtained can be used to develop and create more effective handbooks. In addition, the researchers have recommendations from the research report.

1. Due to the increased effectiveness of the military student enrollment handbook, even though the average has increased, the current handbook is able to perform various functions. Therefore, the researchers recommend adjusting the handbook to keep pace with technology in order to enhance convenience and improve ease of understanding.

2. Since the sample group consists of only 60 individuals, it may not fully represent the opinions of students, parents, and staff. Therefore, the researchers suggest that those interested in conducting research related to military student enrollment consider increasing the sample size to improve accuracy.
