The target of this survey is 2.722 million residents in Chuxiong Yi Autonomous Prefecture, Yunnan Province. Through the questionnaire survey (questionnaire star), a total of 326 valid questionnaires were randomly collected.



Analysis conclusion: According to the data table, 18.4% of the respondents often see the application of Yi elements in interior design, 29.35% of the respondents see it occasionally, 39.92% of the respondents rarely see it, and 12.33% of the respondents have never seen it. It can be seen that most respondents rarely or never see the application of Yi elements in interior design.



Analysis and Conclusion: According to the data analysis, the areas where Yi elements are most suitable for interior design are mainly concentrated in restaurants and commercial spaces, accounting for 38.55% and 18.98% respectively. Next are the living room and study/studio, accounting for 18.4% and 11.94% respectively. The application rate of bedrooms is low, at 10.96%. The applicability of other areas is less, accounting for only 1.17%.



Analysis Conclusion: According to the data table, 66.14% of people think that the application of Yi elements in interior design is very helpful to improve the cultural connotation of space, 19.77% of people think it is helpful, 12.72% of people think it is not helpful, and only 1.37% of people think it is not helpful. Therefore, most people believe that the application of Yi elements in interior design can effectively enhance the cultural connotation of space.



Analysis conclusion: According to the data table, for interior designs containing Yi elements, the most important cultural connotations are mainly auspicious connotations and historical inheritance. Among them, auspicious connotations have been selected 203 times, accounting for 39.73%, and historical inheritance has been selected 181 times, accounting for 35.42%. The importance of national characteristics and artistic aesthetics is relatively low, at 22.7% and 2.15% respectively. In this survey, the "Other" option was not selected. Therefore, it can be seen that in the interior design of Yi elements, auspicious connotations and historical inheritance are regarded as the most important cultural connotations.

A large amount of valuable data and opinions can be collected through questionnaires on the application of Yi elements in interior design.
