RESEARCH OF BLUE AND WHITE PORCELAIN FOR THE RESTAURANT DESIGN

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ABSTRACT

The purpose of this study is to skillfully apply blue and white porcelain art to restaurant space design, combining traditional blue and white porcelain art with modern restaurant space design to explore the feasibility and practical effects of using blue and white porcelain elements in restaurant design. The research collects relevant knowledge and understanding of the application methods of blue and white porcelain aesthetic elements, and verifies their practical effects through case analysis. Additionally, the research aims to deepen the understanding of traditional culture and incorporate scientific decoration techniques into modern restaurant space design, integrating blue and white art elements with space design to achieve innovative design of blue and white art in space design, thereby enhancing the level and connotation of modern space design. The research results are summarized as follows:

1) In restaurant design, skillful use of blue and white porcelain elements can effectively enhance the aesthetic value and cultural connotation of the restaurant, creating an elegant and refined atmosphere that brings customers a delightful and desirable dining experience.

2) The blue and white porcelain elements can also increase customer satisfaction and loyalty, attracting more

INTRODUCTION

Chinese culture has a long history dating back 5,000 years, and it has nurtured a rich and diverse culinary culture. With social progress, the catering industry has gradually transformed from simple dining places into places that also serve as leisure, entertainment, and social gathering venues. Therefore, the design styles have become increasingly personalized and diversified, and themed restaurants have become popular in this context. By incorporating Chinese traditional culture into the design of catering spaces, customers can deeply appreciate the cultural connotations, enhance the core competitiveness of catering businesses, and inject new elements into the diversity of catering space design. However, the market competition is intense, and there is an abundance of similar themed restaurants, leading to consumer aesthetic fatigue. As a representative of traditional Chinese culture, the use of blue and white porcelain in the design of catering spaces can not only reflect the important position of blue and white porcelain art in Chinese traditional culture but also inject unique and abundant elements, making important contributions to the inheritance of blue and white aesthetics culture.

Research Objectives:

1. To understand the cultural connotations and aesthetic features of blue-and-white porcelain, as well as the spatial layout and decorative elements in restaurant design, the design of details such as tableware, lighting, and flooring.

2. To explore customers' reactions and evaluations of the incorporation of blue-and-white porcelain elements in restaurant design through case analysis and questionnaire surveys.

3. To summarize the effects and evaluations of blue-and-white porcelain elements in restaurant design, including the enhancement of restaurant aesthetics and the display of cultural connotations, as well as the feasibility and limitations of practical applications.

METHODOLOGY

This research conducted an in-depth analysis of the aesthetic characteristics and cultural significance of blue and white porcelain. In addition, it explored the value of incorporating blue and white porcelain aesthetics into the design of themed restaurants, injecting new vitality into traditional culture. To achieve these research objectives, the following research methods were adopted:

Data collection: To understand the production process of blue and white porcelain. This required collecting data through various means such as literature, physical samples, and surveys. During this process, had to carefully select and discern the reliability and authoritativeness of the information to ensure the collected data was highly accurate and practical. In addition to understanding the aesthetic features and cultural significance of blue and white porcelain, also needed to collect and analyze case studies of blue and white porcelain-themed restaurants. This required conducting systematic observation and comparison of blue and white porcelain aesthetics, themed restaurant decoration and color, as well as researching and analyzing relevant historical culture and art theory. In this process, needed subject knowledge, keen artistic insight, and high information integration and analysis abilities.

Data collection played a crucial role in the study of blue and white porcelain aesthetics. Through systematic scientific collection and organization of data, can achieve a deeper and more profound understanding and appreciation of the unique charm of blue and white porcelain, and provide powerful support for its inheritance and development.

After careful planning and meticulous arrangement, researchers conducted a study on the culture of blue and white porcelain in Jiujiang City, Jiangxi Province, China, combining qualitative and action research methods to collect primary data. To ensure the accuracy and comprehensiveness of the data, researchers also collected domestic books and literature on the culture of blue and white porcelain as secondary sources of data. They carried out literature searches on the internet and major journal indexes to understand the aesthetic concepts of blue and white porcelain and the design significance of themed restaurants. Among the residents of Jiujiang City, a total of 208 data objects were collected. After analyzing these samples, researchers found that the understanding of blue and white porcelain restaurants varied among individuals, but most people showed a strong interest in this cultural characteristic. At the same time, researchers also discovered that the majority of consumers were very willing to dine at blue and white porcelain themed restaurants to experience the unique charm of the culture. Through this survey, researchers have delved deep into the connotation of blue and white porcelain culture and the trends in the consumer market, providing valuable references and foundations for the development of related industries.

The main conceptual framework adopted in this study is as follows:

1) Conceptual framework for features and aesthetics.

2) Aesthetic conceptual framework integrated with dining space.

3) Survey on the recognition and preference of current residents towards themed restaurants.

4) Evaluation results.



Research Methods

1) Record the aesthetic features and aesthetic value of blue and white porcelain.

2) Survey the user experience and preferences of local people in Jiujiang City, Jiangxi Province.

3) Study cultural literature on the production of blue and white porcelain, including pattern design, color, and production methods.

4) Collect literature and analyze cases to obtain design techniques and artistic features from others.

5) Introduce the data analysis results and research findings in descriptive research and conduct a satisfaction survey on the aesthetics of blue and white porcelain in catering engineering with the following methods:

a) The sample consists of 208 consumers who were intentionally selected from residents in Jiujiang City.

b) Action data analysis is conducted through workshops and seminar projects.

c) Data analysis.

1. Characteristics of Blue-and-White Porcelain

The characteristics of blue-and-white porcelain are mainly reflected in the porcelain body, glaze, and decoration aspects:

(1) Porcelain Body: The porcelain body of blue-and-white porcelain is fine in texture, hard but not brittle, uniform in texture, and has a pure white color.

(2) Glaze: The glaze of blue-and-white porcelain is as bright as a mirror, with a clear and bright glaze color, and full of charm.

(3) Decoration: The decoration of blue-and-white porcelain usually adopts blue-andwhite colors, characterized by a deep, pure, and rich hue of blue, with a certain degree of transparency and stereoscopic effect.

(4) Color: Blue and white tones, with blue patterns on a white background, showing an elegant and beautiful style.

2.Various shapes of blue and white porcelain.

Blue and white porcelain is a fascinating art form used both for everyday purposes and as decorative pieces. Its style is varied and diverse, depending on its intended use. Its beauty lies in the exquisite combination of shape and pattern, with blue flowers against a white background reflecting the wisdom and artistry of our ancestors. In this article, the author seeks to explore the cultural significance of blue and white porcelain, including its various shapes, patterns, and inscriptions. This will be achieved through field research, online searches, book reviews, and museum visits, aimed at collecting relevant materials and classifying them accordingly.

As time has passed, the types and styles of blue and white porcelain have become increasingly diverse. Based on their intended use, these porcelain pieces each have their unique characteristics. In terms of size, they can be divided into two categories: large blue and white porcelain, mainly used for commercial trade exports, and designed to cater to the lifestyle habits of foreign ethnic groups; and small blue and white porcelain, primarily used for local needs and ornamental purposes, with a focus on satisfying local customs and the burial needs of Southeast Asian people. Blue and white porcelain comes in a wide variety of styles, including bottles, pots, jars, boxes, bowls, plates, etc., with diverse shapes. (Figure 1)

3. Various patterns of blue and white porcelain.

In the early days, blue and white patterns were mainly fish patterns, small plum blossom patterns, and also included some basic geometric shapes such as diamonds, which were simple and exquisite. With the progress of the times and the improvement of aesthetic level, the style of blue and white patterns has been more widely developed, covering various aspects such as animals, figures, plants, and auxiliary elements, and a very small amount of poetic elements are also integrated, making it more rich and colorful. 4. The design of blue and white porcelain aesthetics in dining spaces.

Soft furnishings and color design for blue and white porcelain dining space.

In the design of dining cultural spaces, furnishings are an essential component, covering a wide range of items, including tables and chairs, crafts, soft furnishings, tableware, lighting fixtures, and ornamental plants. Good furnishing design can directly enhance the quality of the entire space, so it is necessary to consider the different attributes of the space and coordinate with the entire cultural space to create a themed dining culture environment for the purpose of sublimating people's emotional experiences. Blue and white porcelain art patterns are a very suitable element for restaurant decoration, which can present a new appearance on carriers such as tableware, lighting fixtures, and decorative paintings, and can also be used to create a strong blue and white cultural atmosphere. In addition, the uniform and harmonious color tone of the space and the design of the dining service personnel's clothing are also essential and should be in line with the overall theme to enhance the atmosphere and theme presentation of the entire dining environment. The design of soft furnishings should be coordinated with the entire cultural space to create a themed dining culture environment. (Figure 4,5)

5. Quantitative Analysis

The survey is conducted on approximately 730,000 permanent residents in the urban area of Jiujiang, Jiangxi Province. A total of 206 valid questionnaires were collected through a random questionnaire survey (using Questionnaire Star).

Analysis Conclusion: According to the data table, there were a total of 208 valid responses. Among them, 48.08% were male and 51.92% were female. It can be seen that the number of male and female respondents in this single-choice question is similar, presenting a relatively balanced gender distribution. (Figure 6)

Analysis conclusion: According to the data table, the number of valid responders for this multiple-choice question is 206. Among them, the age group of 18-25 has the highest number of people, accounting for 30.77%; followed by the age group of 25-35, accounting for 25%; the age groups of under 18, 35-45, and above 45 account for 14.9%, 17.31%, and 12.02%, respectively. It can be seen that the majority of the population who participated in this multiple-choice question are young people, with the age group of 18-35 accounting for as high as 55.77%. (Figure 7)

Analysis conclusion: In this survey, the participants' occupations mainly focused on three groups: students, staff, and freelancers, with staff accounting for the highest proportion at 51.44%. Students ranked second, accounting for 25%, while freelancers accounted for 17.31%. Other occupational groups had a relatively small proportion, only 6.25%. (Figure 8)

Analysis conclusion: According to the data table, a total of 208 people participated in the study, of whom 75.48% had visited theme restaurants with blue-and-white aesthetics, while 24.52% had not. This result indicates that blue-and-white aesthetics have a high level of recognition and appeal in theme restaurant spaces, and also suggests that this art style has significant commercial value. Analysis conclusion: According to the data table, the number of valid responses for this question is 206, with the most popular option being "enhancing the charm of food", accounting for 71.63%. The second most popular option is "excellent visual effect", accounting for 47.6%. The "highly artistic" option has a percentage of 46.15%. In addition, only a few people chose the "other" option. (Figure 10)
