The art office not only has an independent office unit, but also serves as a space for creative activities, There is also a relatively open shared area for displaying some of your own artwork. Wang Shu's research and design works demonstrate his in-depth thinking and innovative practice on the environment, culture and space [3], and have made important contributions to the development of Chinese contemporary art and architecture.

In the design of the art studio, the utilization rate of the space and the aesthetic feeling of the design itself are emphasized, and the limited space can be used to the maximum through the reasonable division of functional partitions. At the same time, more original materials are used in the selection of materials , and emphasize the presentation of its own texture, which can not only bring a distinctive aesthetic feeling, but also save the cost of the art studio while further integrating into nature.

In terms of the function of the art studio, it can not only meet the individual needs of young art practitioners, but also echo with the surrounding environment and reflect their own social value. Young art practitioners can carry out works through the semi-public area of the art studio At the same time, it receives customers and other young art practitioners for artistic exchanges. In free time, this area can also be rented out to relieve the financial pressure of young art practitioners.

As more and more young art practitioners begin to enter the society, the economic benefits brought by the art market are getting higher and higher, and the status of the art market will become more and more important. For young art practitioners, a Belonging to one's own, an excellent art studio is an indispensable product.

RFSEARCH PROBLEMS

This research is aimed at the development and design of art office in today's art market. Based on the needs and current situation of young art practitioners, an art office for young art practitioners is designed according to the design style of artist Wang Shu. The research process first analyzed Wang Shu's famous art office design works, then designed a questionnaire according to his style and collected more than 100 questionnaire results feedback, from which we learned the public's suggestions for the research. The method is as follows: literature research, case analysis, questionnaire survey, questionnaire analysis.

RESULT

In the book "The Beginning of Design" [4] written by Wang Shu, the first design work at the beginning is the art office designed by Wang Shu for his friend Chen Mo. As the first work in the book, Chen Mo's art office It is very representative of Wang Shu's ideas and creativity.






Figure 1 Chen Mo Art office

Chen Mo Art office is located in an office building in Xiashi Town, Haining City, Zhejiang Province, China, with a total area of about 60 square meters. Wang Shu divided the space of the art office into four abstract concepts, forming four areas, namely the corridor, interior space, platform and wall, and through the mutual combination and arrangement of these four areas, More regions are formed.

Corridors made of steel plates connect various areas. The indoor curved wall not connected to the roof is not only a wall for dividing areas, but also a natural display wall. The platform is like a stage, becoming the focus of sight. In Chen Mo's art office, Wang Shu used the limited area to produce many different effects through design and combination, and used the most authentic texture of materials as decoration to express the most authentic and simple design language.

Through the analysis and summary of Wang Shu's design style, a questionnaire was designed, and after random distribution, the results of the questionnaire were fed back. After data analysis, it can be seen that most of the surveyed objects are engaged in the field of painting and design for more than 5 years Young Artists.




Figure 2 Young art practitioners' needs and layout preferences for art offices

In terms of space design, more emphasis should be placed on space design, focusing on the light and dark changes of the space in different states of opening and closing, so that a space can show different aesthetics through different changes, and increase the utilization rate of the space, in this way to arouse people Resonance with architecture.

When designing an art office, we should also pay attention to its functionality, examine the surrounding environment, and consider the needs of the community and society, so that the art office is not obtrusive and independent, but can be integrated with the environment, so that It becomes a design with social value. This return to the aesthetic feeling of the design itself Art office design is the most recognized.

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
